No stall applications accepted that are postmarked after August 1!

General Regulations:

- a) Friday Show only Entry fees are \$5/class until postmark of August 1 and \$7/class for entries there after until 7:00 a.m. the morning of the show with all paper work and fees inclusive. Sign ups after this time will be \$8/class. No substitution of classes allowed. See Gymkhana, page 12, for fees.
- b) *All exhibitors must purchase a membership to the Essex County Agricultural Society (\$25.00) which allows entry to grounds for the extent of fair (excludes grandstand and rides). Must show proof of membership to enter grounds or you will be charged daily entry fee (refunds at office with proof of membership). **Application and membership fee must accompany all entry forms.**
- c) ** Refer to Ag & Markets rules for “Animal Health Requirements for Admission to NYS and County Fairs”. A current Negative Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) (Coggins) test is required. Current Rabies Vaccinations are required. Out of State exhibitors must also have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI). **The aforementioned should be included with entries along with copies of breed registrations where required.**
- d) *All horses stabled for duration of fair are to be on grounds by 5 p.m., Tuesday, August 9 and remain until 6 p.m., Sunday, August 14 to be awarded premiums. 4-H horses are required to be stabled all week and will be considered first in stall designation, the rest will be by first come first serve basis. Stalls for the week are \$10/stall. Stalls used for tack carry the same charge. If 75% of the stalls are requested then everyone will be given their preference as indicated on the form. If less than 75% of the stalls are filled then those requesting to truck in will have to stable on the grounds. Truck in exhibitors that will be on the grounds for more than one day may request an overnight stall for \$10/night. Please submit “Essex County Fair Horse Show Application” on page 5 prior to August 1.
- e) *Beginner, Junior, and Senior riders must wear **approved** SEI/ASTM helmet and appropriate foot wear when ever mounted on a horse. All Friday classes should be in formal show attire. Wednesday Gymkhana tack optional, formal or informal attire (T-shirt or Polo Shirt appreciated).
- f) Ages as of January 1, 2011 - Beginner is someone who can walk-trot only. They are not allowed to canter in any class; Junior, ages 9-13; Senior, ages 14-18; Adults, ages 19 and above. Youth and adults will be awarded separately. Stallions may be handled by Adults ONLY!
- g) The Essex County Fair Horse Show Application Form is on page 5. The Friday Essex County Fair Horse Show Entry Form is the form on page 6, and the Wednesday & Sunday Gymkhana Show Entry Form is the form on page 7.
- h) **Please send Applications and all entries for Friday Essex County Fair Show and Wednesday & Sunday Gymkhana, with fees (checks made out to Essex County Fair) and copies of Rabies, EIA, CVI, and Breed Registration papers to: Karleena Vaughan, 8586 US Route 9, Lewis, NY 12950.** Please call 828-808-6207 or 518-873-9565 with any questions or email: kmv132002@yahoo.com.

*Regulation covers Wednesday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday. **Covers any horse entering grounds.

Essex County Fair Friday Horse Show Awards
Rosettes will be awarded in 1st through 6th place.
1st through 4th placing will pay as follows: \$14, \$12, \$10, \$8

High Point Awards

Awards will be given to the persons with high point scores in each division of English Classes, Western Classes, and Trail Classes. A reserve award will be given respectively to the persons with second highest scores.

Trail High Point Award

To be awarded to the person with the highest score of all divisions, having completed Trail Class. Special Trail is for those a horse 6 years or younger that has never placed in a trail class. No side pass in this class.

High Point Jumping Award

Award will be given to the person with the highest point score for jumping in classes indicated in class list under this award. A reserve award will be presented to the person with the second highest score in these classes.

Performance Award

An award will be given to the person who demonstrates excellence in horsemanship with obvious enjoyment of the sport in the following areas: Grooming, Training, and Presentation. Judge and show officials will determine winner of this award.

Sportsmanship Award

This award will be presented to the person who shows most kindness to his or her horse, shows enjoyment in showing, and gives support and encouragement to fellow riders. Judge and show officials will determine winner of this award.

Stall Award

To be awarded for the best decorated stall with a Floral Theme. Only stalls rented for the week will be eligible. If you set up a display as a family, one award will be presented. Please indicate at bottom of entry form if you are planning to enter. There is no entry fee.

You can ask for your favorites as well. Essex County Horse Show rules apply.

AWARDS: Rosettes will be awarded for 1st through 6th place to all riders. **High Point** worth \$50 payback and **Reserve High Point** worth \$30 payback will be awarded in each division.

Entry Fees: \$25.00 if postmarked by August 1, \$40.00 if postmarked after. No entries will be received after 12 p.m. Wednesday. Games will be posted the afternoon of the show. Use the entry form on page 7.

This year will run at 9:00 a.m. to noon. This years games are open to all Junior, Senior, and Adults. We will do as many games as our horses will allow.

AWARDS: Rosettes will be awarded for 1st through 6th place to all riders. **High Point** worth \$75 payback and **Reserve High Point** worth \$40 payback will be awarded in each division. An **Over All High Point** will be awarded with a payback of \$100. Points awarded based on a minimum of three entries per class.

Entry Fees: \$25.00 if postmarked by August 1, \$40.00 if postmarked after. No entries will be received after 8:30 a.m. Sunday morning.
