GENERAL RULES

Entry fee 10% of First Premium

1. A cock or a hen is a male or female bird respectively, hatched prior to January of this year. A cockerel or a pullet is a male or female bird respectively, hatched since January of this year.
2. All poultry entered for premiums must be owned by the exhibitor for at least 30 days before the Fair.
3. No premiums will be awarded on birds not true to the breed or which are sick or of low vitality or which in any way are unworthy of a prize.
4. All standard disqualifications will apply in judging.
5. The same bird cannot compete in two classes.
6. All specimens will be shown singly or in pens. A pen consists of one male and two females. In the case of crossbreeds a pen means three females.
7. A trio is two females and one male.
8. Note the poultry health requirements under Animal Health Requirements.

Judging

Methods of judging production classes will be by the demonstration method. Exhibitors may be present at the time the birds are judged. No discussion by the exhibitors will be allowed while judging is in progress. The judge will give his reasons for awarding or not awarding a prize to any bird.
