## CONDITIONS

On Track Driver/Trainer Accident Insurance provided through Life Insurance Company of North America.

Events 5, 6, 7, and 8 will be raced as overnights with a declaration fee of \$10 (May be retained by the track).

HORSES MUST START IN THE CLASS THEY ARE NOMINATED TO, NO MOVING UP. Horses changing gait will be placed in proper classes. In case of error in naming in, a horse may change to the proper class.

Each dash will be the distance of one mile. Two dashes to a race unless otherwise stated. If the number of horses declared in to start exceeds twice the number of scoring positions for one tier, the race shall be raced in elimination heats or may be split divisions and race one dash. Five declarations are needed to fill an event. If the event does not fill the Race Secretary reserves the right to open or cancel the race.

The money will be divided as follows: 50, 25, 12, 8, and 5 percent each dash. Four starters: 50, 25, 15, and 10 percent each dash. Three starters: 50, 30, and 20 percent each dash. Two starters: 65 and 35 percent each dash.

Rules of the United States Trotting Association to govern with no exceptions. The New York Sire Stakes are closed and will race according to their published conditions.

All horses must have a negative Coggins Test Certificate issued within the previous twelve months and proof of a Rabies Vaccination. All horses must parade to post unless excused officially. Drivers must wear colors while warming up.

Once declared, the starting fee is due and payable.

Declarations must be filled out in full, **INCLUDING DRIVER'S AND TRAINER'S NAME AND NUMBER.** Persons wishing to make telephone declarations must have all information ready when calling in. All horses declared to start, must start and be driven by the specified drivers unless excused by the Judges.

Horses entered at this meet are done so at the owner's risk. The owner or his agent agree to indemnify the management against all claims, demands, suits and expenses arising out of any personal injury or damage to any property caused by his horses, attendants or himself. All horses are subject to saliva, urine and blood testing if and when deemed appropriate by the Judges or Sponsor.

Stalls are on a first come, first served basis. All horses stabled at the track but not racing at this meet will be asked to move.

Out of state horses must have a Health Certificate.

The right is reserved to decline any entry, change the order of the program without further advertising or call off races that cannot be started due to weather conditions or any unavoidable circumstances or emergency that might arise.
