General Rules

1. The show will start at 8:00 AM **sharp** on Saturday (rain or shine).
2. A pre-entry fee of \$5.00 will be charged for each class entered if received by August 4, 2011 (payment must accompany the **entry form on page 3** to receive pre-entry fee rate!!). Late entries will be charged \$7.00 per class. **NO REFUNDS!!!**
3. Early entries are encouraged, but registration on the day of the show will begin at 7:00 AM.
4. Entry fees must be paid prior to participation in any given class.
5. Horses may be trucked in the day of the show, but must have proof of a **current NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST (EIA)** (dated 2010 OR 2011 only) and **RABIES VACCINATION** (dated 2011 only). Please mail a copy of each with the entry form on page 3. Stabling will not be provided.
6. Stallions should meet the requirements of the State Stallion Enrollment Board for soundness and cannot be shown by anyone under the age of 18.
7. Ponies shall be considered 14.2 hands and under.
8. A Junior Horse (4 years old or younger) may be ridden with two hands.
9. **ALL PERSONS AGED 19 AND UNDER MUST WEAR AN APPROVED HELMET (a sewn-in SEI ASTM 1163 label) WHEN RIDING OR DRIVING A HORSE ON THE FAIRGROUNDS.**
10. Tack optional in gymkhana classes.
11. Beginners may be led in gymkhana classes only.
12. All classes requiring patterns will be posted the day of the show.
13. Order of Classes may be changed at the discretion of the Show Stewards.
14. Classes of less than three horses may be canceled or combined.
15. Six ribbons will be awarded per class.
16. Points in each division are given for a one horse, one rider combination.
17. A Champion Rosette will be awarded to the high point winner in each performance division (#1 - #27) and gymkhana division (#28 - #42).
18. The top two overall high point winners of the day will receive a Grand Champion ribbon and \$70.00 or a Reserve Grand Champion ribbon and \$30.00.
19. A Beginner will be a person of any age who can only walk and jog/trot, but who may also be beginning to lope/canter. Entries in this division may lope/canter in jumping and gymkhana classes only.
20. A Junior will be 13 years old or younger as of January 1 this year.
21. A Senior will be 14 - 18 years old as of January 1 this year.
22. An Adult will be 19 years old or older as of January 1 this year.
23. Additional rules may be posted the day of the show.
24. The AQHA rules will apply for all classes except where otherwise specified in the general rules or class listings.
25. The Judge's decision is final.

4. Leadline - Open to all beginner riders. Riders competing in this class cannot enter any other class except costume class. Tack optional. No points awarded for this class!

24. Cross Rails Equitation Over Fences - Open to all horses and ponies. Entries in this class will not be penalized for trotting. Horse/rider combinations entered in this class cannot compete in classes #26 or #27.
25. Cross Rails Hunter Over Fences - Same as class #24 except to be judged on horse's performance and entries may be asked to jog their horses for soundness.
26. Equitation Over Fences - Open to all horses and ponies. Jumps to be 18 inches to 2 feet. Horse/rider combinations entered in this class cannot compete in classes #24 or #25.
27. Low Working Hunter Over Fences - Same as class #26 except to be judged on horse's performance and entries may be asked to jog their horses for soundness.
