

TRUCK & TRACTOR PULLS

GENERAL RULES

1. No alcohol on the grounds.
2. No alcoholic beverage before or during the pull
3. No children under 16 years of age allowed in the pit area unless supervised by an adult.

Since reasonable rules cannot cover any and all eventualities, the discretion of the Judges will prevail, including safety, operations, equipment, good sportsmanship and common sense. Safety will be paramount.

FARM STOCK TRACTOR RULES

1. All tractors must be of stock appearance with stock hood, grill and fenders and working PTO.
2. All tractors with a turbo must be of stock size and have a vertical exhaust pipe at least 18 inches high unless it has a stock muffler then a curved pipe is allowable.
3. All tractors must have wheelie bars or you may chain the 3-point hitch arms down under the draw bar.
4. All tractors must have at least a 3 inch hole in the hitching device.
5. Hitch height is 20 inch max.
6. All weights must be securely fastened. Any lost weight will constitute disqualification.
7. No cut tires allowed.
8. Engine rpms not to exceed 3000 rpm
9. Each tractor may be entered in a max of 2 classes.
10. Judges, flagmen and officials have the right to disqualify anyone on or off the track for operating a tractor in an unsafe manner. No riders on tractors.

Any tractor appearing to not be stock will be disqualified and not allowed to pull. Right or wrong the Judges decision is final.

ALTERED STOCK TRACTOR RULES

1. All tractors must be of stock appearance with original hood, grill and fenders and stock block with no modification.
2. Turbo limited to 3-inch inlet and 3 inch outlet. Exhaust must exit vertical with at least an 18 inch pipe. No curved pipes.
3. Turbo exhaust pipe must have 2 3/8" bolts crossing each other.
4. No cut tires.
5. All tractors must have wheelie bars able to support tractor.
6. Maximum hitch height will be 20 inches. Minimum drawbar length will be 18 inches from center of axle to hitch eye.
7. All tractors must have an air shut off for diesels and an electrical shut off for gas engines
8. All tractors must have side shields and a safety blanket.
9. All drivers must wear safety equipment (helmet and fire suit).
10. Judges have the right to disqualify anyone on or off the track for unsafe operation of there tractor or unsportsmanlike like conduct.

STREET LEGAL 4WD TRUCK RULES

1. Clevis or working hitch with 3 inch minimum opening.
2. DOT street legal tires - no cut tires.
3. Helmets mandatory.
4. Proof of current License, Registration, and Inspection with Insurance Card must be presented for the vehicle being entered. Registration must match vehicle being entered and license must be for the competing driver.
5. All weights must be securely attached. No weights in the cab.
6. Drawbar height of 26 inches (maximum height).
7. The driver of the vehicle must be operating the truck when weighing in.
8. All body parts must be within the vehicle while pulling.
9. Pump gasoline only. No alcohol or nitrous.
